Instructions for USH Ushers

Thank you so much for serving as ushers for your friends' festive occasion!

The following is a description of your role as an usher.

- (a) Please arrive not later than 9:30am.
- (b) Each usher (or team of ushers) should stand in the back of the sanctuary near one of the doors.
- (c) As people arrive, please hand them the following items:
 - a siddur (see picture)
 - a Shabbat service brochure ("The Shabbat Service in 5½ acts")
 - EITHER a Humash (see picture), or when available a set of Torah reading photocopies.

It may be useful to insert the photocopied materials (brochure and torah reading photocopies, described above) into the siddur.

(d) Be generally helpful, (quietly) answer questions, direct people to the bathrooms, etc.

Once most of the people have arrived (probably by 11am), your role is simply to be available in case of need. The most important part of the role is from the beginning of the service until 11am.
